

Tyne and Wear County Association offer 4 different league opportunities. All our leagues are for affiliated players only. Opportunities for non affiliated players are available within Tyne and Wear and anyone teams interested in these should apply to the League Secretary for details.

County Winter League

This league runs from September to February and all entries are made at the county's AGM in July. The league has 90 teams divided into 9 divisions currently. Games are played on weekday evenings between 6.30 and 9.30, indoor at the Blue Flames Sporting Centre in Forest Hall. Teams get 9, hour long games (4 x 12 minute quarters) and have to provide a qualified umpire who is used neutrally. The current cost of the league is £125 per team.

The winter league is a competitive league with relegations and promotions applied at the completion of the games. Entrants are expected to fulfil all their fixtures and umpiring commitments and penalties are strictly applied where rules are broken.

All players must be affiliated to England Netball via Tyne and Wear county, this may be via a second affiliation payment. Clubs with more than one team are required to nominate players to teams and a playing up rule is applied.

County Spring League

This league runs from March to July and all entries are made at the county's General Meeting in January. The league has 81 teams divided into 8 divisions currently. Games are played on weekday evenings between 6.30 and 9.30, indoor at the Blue Flames Sporting Centre in Forest Hall. Teams get 9, hour long games (4 x 12 minute quarters) and have to provide a qualified umpire who is used neutrally. The current cost of the league is £125 per team.

The spring league is a competitive league with relegations and promotions applied at the completion of the games. Entrants are expected to fulfil all their fixtures and umpiring commitments and penalties are strictly applied where rules are broken.

All players must be affiliated to England Netball via Tyne and Wear county, this may be via a second affiliation payment. Clubs with more than one team are required to nominate players to teams and a playing up rule is applied.

County Outdoor League

This league runs from May to July and expressions of interest are taken at the county's General Meeting in January and confirmed by email in March. The league has 16 teams currently divided into 2 divisions of 8 teams. Games are played on Tuesday evenings between 7.00 and 9.00, outdoors at the Burnside Community College in Wallsend. Teams get 9, hour long games (4 x 12 minute quarters) and have to provide a qualified umpire who is used neutrally. The current cost of the league is £66 per team. This league is run on a participative rather than competitive basis.

All players must be affiliated to England Netball and can only represent one team in the league. Team squads may consist of any number of players from a mix of affiliated clubs.

Summer Holidays League

The league runs during the 6 week school summer holidays. Expressions of interest are made at the county's General Meeting in January and confirmed in May via email. The league has 18 teams currently divided into 2 divisions currently. Games are played on a Wednesday evening between 6.30 and 9.30, indoor at the Blue Flames Sporting Centre in Forest Hall. Games consist of four 12 minutes quarters. Teams also have to provide a qualified umpire who is used neutrally. The current cost of the league is £85 per team. This league is run on a participative rather than competitive basis.

All players must be affiliated to England Netball and can only represent one team in the league. Team squads may consist of any number of players from a mix of affiliated clubs.
